AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 44, CHAPTER 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 27; RELATING TO EMERGENCY TECHNOLOGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 44, chapter 9, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding article 27, to read:

4 ARTICLE 27. EMERGENCY ALERT TECHNOLOGY

5 44-1383. Definitions

6 IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

7 1. "EMERGENCY ALERT TECHNOLOGY" MEANS A HANDS-FREE TECHNOLOGY THAT
8 SENDS AN AUDIBLE WARNING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVERS WHO ARE IN THE PATH OF
9 OR ARE APPROACHING AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE.

10 2. "MOTOR VEHICLE" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION
11 28-101.

12 3. "PORTABLE WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE" HAS THE SAME MEANING
13 PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 28-914.

14 44-1383.01. Emergency alert technology; vehicles and devices;

16 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, ALL NEW MOTOR VEHICLES AND PORTABLE
17 WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES THAT ARE SOLD IN THIS STATE MUST CONTAIN
18 EMERGENCY ALERT TECHNOLOGY.
