AN ACT

**AMENDING SECTIONS 32-532 AND 32-557, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
COSMETOLOGY.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-532, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-532. Instructors; license reciprocity

5 Notwithstanding section 32-531, a person is entitled to receive a
6 license to teach cosmetology, aesthetics, nail technology or hairstyling
7 in a school if the person submits to the board an application for an
8 instructor license on a form prescribed by the board, pays the prescribed
9 fees and complies with one of the following:

10 1. Is a current licensed cosmetologist, aesthetician, nail
11 technician or hairstylist instructor in another state or country **OR HAS AT**
12 **LEAST ONE YEAR OF INSTRUCTOR EXPERIENCE IN ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY.**

13 2. Does all of the following:

14 (a) Either:

15 (i) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
16 at least eighteen years of age.

17 (ii) Holds a diploma from a high school or its equivalent as
18 prescribed by the board in its rules and submits to the board satisfactory
19 evidence that the person is at least sixteen years of age.

20 (b) Is a licensed cosmetologist, aesthetician, nail technician or
21 hairstylist in another state or country **OR HAS AT LEAST ONE YEAR OF**
22 **INSTRUCTOR EXPERIENCE IN ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY.**

23 (c) Completes instructor training in another state or country that
24 has instructor education requirements that are at least substantially
25 equivalent to those of this state.

26 (d) Passes the examination for an instructor license.

27 (e) Has five years of licensed industry experience within the ten
28 years preceding application.

29 (f) Meets requirements as prescribed by the board in its rules.

30 Sec. 2. Section 32-557, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
31 read:

32 32-557. Services for the public; restrictions

33 A. Students may render services to the public only under the direct
34 supervision of an instructor.

35 B. The following notice shall be posted in a conspicuous place
36 within the school in letters large enough to be read across the length of
37 the room, "school of cosmetology – work done exclusively by students."

38 C. A student in a school shall not receive a salary or commission
39 from the school for any cosmetology, aesthetics, nail technology or
40 hairstyling services while enrolled in the school as a student. **A STUDENT**
41 **WHO IS ENROLLED IN A SCHOOL AND WHO INTENDS TO BECOME AN INSTRUCTOR MAY BE**
42 **A PAID EMPLOYEE OF THE SCHOOL.**

43 D. A school shall post a price list for services rendered to the
44 public that is large enough to be easily read from a distance of ten feet.
