LIABILITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 4-301, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 4-301. Liability limitation; social host

5 A person other than a licensee or an employee of a licensee acting
6 during the employee's working hours or in connection with such employment
7 is not liable in damages to any person who is injured, or to the survivors
8 of any person killed, or for damage to property, which is alleged to have
9 been caused in whole or in part by reason of the furnishing or serving of
10 spirituous liquor to a person of AT LEAST the legal drinking age.
