## AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 20-826.05; AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 20-1057.20; AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 20-1342.08; AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 20-1402.06; RELATING TO HEALTH CARE INSURANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Title 20, chapter 4, article 3, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 20-826.05, to read:

4       20-826.05. Rate of coverage; covered service; reimbursement;  
5                   pharmacist

6       A. TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY FEDERAL LAW, A HOSPITAL SERVICE  
7 CORPORATION OR MEDICAL SERVICE CORPORATION THAT ISSUES, AMENDS, DELIVERS  
8 OR RENEWS A SUBSCRIPTION CONTRACT ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS  
9 SECTION SHALL PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT COVERAGE TO A PHARMACIST AT A RATE NOT  
10 LESS THAN THE RATE PROVIDED TO THE FOLLOWING:

11       1. A PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13  
12 OR 17.

13       2. A NURSE PRACTITIONER WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32,  
14 CHAPTER 15.

15       3. A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32,  
16 CHAPTER 25.

17       B. IN ORDER FOR THE SERVICE OR PROCEDURE TO BE COVERED:

18       1. THE PHARMACIST MUST ACT WITHIN THE LAWS OF THE PHARMACIST'S  
19 SCOPE OF PRACTICE PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 18.

20       2. THE SERVICE OR PROCEDURE WOULD OTHERWISE BE COVERED UNDER THE  
21 POLICY.

31       A. TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY FEDERAL LAW, A HEALTH CARE SERVICES  
32 ORGANIZATION THAT ISSUES, AMENDS, DELIVERS OR RENEWS AN EVIDENCE OF  
33 COVERAGE ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE  
34 REIMBURSEMENT COVERAGE TO A PHARMACIST AT A RATE NOT LESS THAN THE RATE  
35 PROVIDED TO THE FOLLOWING:

36       1. A PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13  
37 OR 17.

38       2. A NURSE PRACTITIONER WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32,

13 ISSUES, AMENDS, DELIVERS OR RENEWS A POLICY ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE  
14 OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT COVERAGE TO A PHARMACIST AT A  
15 RATE NOT LESS THAN THE RATE PROVIDED TO THE FOLLOWING:

37 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT  
38 COVERAGE TO A PHARMACIST AT A RATE NOT LESS THAN THE RATE PROVIDED TO THE  
39 FOLLOWING:
