HOUSE BILL 2285

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; department of transportation;
3 freeway interchange; Interstate 10; Jackrabbit
4 Trail; intent; reversion; exemption

5 A. In addition to any other appropriation made in fiscal year
6 2022-2023, the sum of \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the state general
7 fund in fiscal year 2022-2023 to the department of transportation to
8 design a freeway interchange on Interstate 10 at Jackrabbit Trail.

9 B. The sum of \$30,000,000 in fiscal year 2023-2024 and \$35,000,000
10 in fiscal year 2024-2025 are appropriated from the state general fund to
11 the department of transportation to construct a freeway interchange on
12 Interstate 10 at Jackrabbit Trail, including:

13 1. All traffic control devices for on-ramps and off-ramps related
14 to the freeway interchange.

15 2. All related and necessary traffic control devices to the north
16 and south of the freeway interchange at Jackrabbit Trail and McDowell
17 Road.

18 C. The legislature intends that the department of transportation
19 use any federal monies available for the projects described in this
20 section to supplement the monies appropriated to the department of
21 transportation by this section. If the department of transportation
22 receives federal monies for a project described in this section, the
23 department of transportation shall revert to the state general fund an
24 amount equal to the amount of federal monies received but not more than
25 the total amount appropriated by this section.

26 D. The legislature intends that the design and construction of the
27 freeway interchange at Jackrabbit Trail be accelerated. The department of
28 transportation shall use the construction-manager-at-risk project delivery
29 method prescribed in section 34-602, subsection A, paragraph 2, Arizona
30 Revised Statutes, to complete this project.

31 E. The appropriations made in subsection A and B of this section
32 are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised
33 Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations.
