## **HB 2310**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL AUDIT BY THE AUDITOR GENERAL OF THE COUNTIES IN THIS STATE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Auditor general review of counties; law  
3 enforcement; retention bonuses; delayed repeal

4 A. Pursuant to section 41-1279.03, Arizona Revised Statutes, the  
5 auditor general shall perform a special audit of each county in this state  
6 to examine and ensure that the \$48,310,000 distributed for payments to  
7 line-level deputies and detention officers employed by each county  
8 sheriff's office under Laws 2022, chapter 313, section 110, subsection A,  
9 paragraph 8, subdivision (a) is being used properly.

10 B. On or before December 31, 2023, the auditor general shall submit  
11 its report of the special audit to the governor, the president of the  
12 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and provide a copy  
13 of this report to the secretary of state.

14 C. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2024.
