## AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-410.01; RELATING TO CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-410.01, to read:

4 **16-410.01. Legislative findings; legislative intent;**  
5 **transparency; effect**

6 THE LEGISLATURE FINDS THAT PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN ELECTIONS IS BEST  
7 MAINTAINED BY MAXIMIZING TRANSPARENCY AND PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING RULE OF  
8 CONSTRUCTION AND DECLARATION OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR INTERPRETING THIS  
9 CHAPTER AND THE INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCEDURES MANUAL PRESCRIBED BY SECTION  
10 16-452:

11 1. THE LEGISLATURE DECLARES THAT THE PURPOSE OF THIS CHAPTER IS TO  
12 PROVIDE THE PEOPLE OF THIS STATE WITH A TRANSPARENT SYSTEM FOR CONDUCTING  
13 ELECTIONS. THEREFORE, COMPETING INTERPRETATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS  
14 CHAPTER SHALL NOT BE GIVEN EQUAL WEIGHT. RATHER, IF THERE ARE TWO  
15 COMPETING INTERPRETATIONS, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE  
16 AGGRESSIVELY CONSTRUED IN FAVOR OF THE READING THAT PROVIDES GREATER  
17 TRANSPARENCY.

18 2. THE LEGISLATURE DECLARES THAT EXISTING COURT OPINIONS RELATING  
19 TO THIS CHAPTER DO NOT HAVE PRECEDENTIAL FORCE OR EFFECT IF THE OPINIONS  
20 CONFLICT WITH THE RULE OF CONSTRUCTION PRESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS  
21 SECTION.
