2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Section 41-3023.11, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,
5 is amended by adding section 41-3031.11, to read:
6 41-3031.11. Law enforcement merit system council; termination
7 July 1, 2031
8 A. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT MERIT SYSTEM COUNCIL TERMINATES ON JULY 1,
9 2031.
10 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 10 AND THIS SECTION ARE REPEALED
11 ON JANUARY 1, 2032.
12 Sec. 3. Purpose
13 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
14 the legislature continues the law enforcement merit system council to
15 provide professional services and oversight for the selection, retention,
16 promotion and dismissal of employees of agencies under the council's
17 jurisdiction.
18 Sec. 4. Retroactivity
19 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to from and
20 after July 1, 2023.
