**AN ACT**

**AMENDING SECTION 4-204, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSING.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 4-204, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 4-204. Personal representative or fiduciary acting for  
5 licensee

6 A. A person acting as administrator, executor or guardian of the  
7 estate of any licensee or a person acting as receiver for any licensee,  
8 trustee of the bankrupt estate of any licensee or assignee for the benefit  
9 of creditors of a licensee is authorized, ~~upon~~ ON receiving permission  
10 from the director, to sell and deal in spirituous liquors under authority  
11 of the license issued to the licensee for whom the person is acting for a  
12 period not exceeding twenty-four months from the date of the appointment  
13 of such person as administrator, executor, guardian, receiver, trustee or  
14 assignee for the benefit of creditors.

15 B. ~~The provisions of~~ This section ~~shall~~ DOES not apply if at any  
16 time during the twenty-four months an administrator, executor or guardian  
17 of the estate of a licensee who has received the permission from the  
18 director as provided in subsection A of this section transfers the license  
19 to the surviving spouse or the guardian of the minor child of the  
20 licensee.

21 C. A person, authorized representative or assignee, ~~meeting the~~  
22 qualifications of section 4-202, not licensed under ~~the provisions of~~ this  
23 chapter, ~~AND~~ AND owning or possessing spirituous liquor as a result of  
24 enforcement of a security interest in the property of a wholesaler  
25 licensed under this chapter is authorized, ~~upon~~ ON receiving permission  
26 from the director, to sell such spirituous liquor to a licensee authorized  
27 to sell spirituous liquor for resale. Sections 4-201, 4-203 and 4-243.01  
28 shall not apply to nor restrict the authority granted under this ~~provision~~  
29 SUBSECTION.
