### **AN ACT**

REPEALING SECTION 41-3023.16, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3029.16; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA OUTDOOR RECREATION COORDINATING COMMISSION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Repeal  
3 Section 41-3023.16, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.  
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
5 is amended by adding section 41-3029.16, to read:  
6 41-3029.16. Arizona outdoor recreation coordinating  
7 commission; termination July 1, 2029  
8 A. THE ARIZONA OUTDOOR RECREATION COORDINATING COMMISSION  
9 TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2029.  
10 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1.2 AND THIS SECTION ARE REPEALED  
11 ON JANUARY 1, 2030.  
12 Sec. 3. Purpose  
13 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
14 the legislature continues the Arizona outdoor recreation coordinating  
15 commission to provide for the distribution of federal and state monies for  
16 recreation projects in this state and to assist and advise the Arizona  
17 state parks board.  
18 Sec. 4. Retroactivity  
19 Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply retroactively to from and after  
20 July 1, 2023.
