AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; department of health services;  
3 trauma-informed training; intent

4 A. The sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ is appropriated from the state general fund  
5 in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the department of health services for  
6 trauma-informed training. The department shall use these monies to  
7 contract with an entity to provide a twelve-month training program that  
8 includes providing:

9 1. Training and technical assistance for participating  
10 organizations in identifying needs and assessing change relating to  
11 trauma-informed assessment, inquiries and protocols.

12 2. Technical assistance to review policies and procedures that need  
13 to be aligned in a trauma-informed way.

14 3. Regional coordinators to provide technical assistance, including  
15 organizational visits, training and facilitating a community of practice,  
16 to the trauma-informed ambassadors within a participating organization.

17 B. The legislature intends that each full-time regional coordinator  
18 not support more than twenty participating organizations each year.
