# HOUSE BILL 2632

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE STATE TREASURER.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; state treasurer; training  
3 simulators

4 A. The sum of \$1,668,000 is appropriated from the peace officer  
5 training equipment fund established by section 41-1731, Arizona Revised  
6 Statutes, in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the state treasurer for training  
7 simulators.

8 B. The state treasurer shall distribute the monies appropriated in  
9 subsection A of this section in the following amounts to the following  
10 recipients to purchase the listed training simulator:

11 1. \$300,000 to the Flagstaff police department to purchase a V-300  
12 LE simulator.

13 2. \$300,000 to the Mohave county probation department to purchase a  
14 V-300 LE simulator.

15 3. \$300,000 to the Gila county sheriff's office to purchase a V-300  
16 LE simulator.

17 4. \$138,000 to the Casa Grande police department to purchase a  
18 V-180 LE simulator.

19 5. \$330,000 to the Maricopa county sheriff's office to purchase a  
20 V-300 LE simulator.

21 6. \$300,000 to the Navajo county sheriff's office to purchase a  
22 V-300 LE simulator.

23 Sec. 2. Legislative intent

24 The legislature intends that the training simulator devices  
25 purchased pursuant to this act will be used for de-escalation and tactical  
26 training as well as training on effective ways to deal with autistic, deaf  
27 or mentally ill communities.
