AMENDING SECTION 41-1234.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
REGULATION AND REGISTRATION OF LOBBYISTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1234.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 41-1234.01. Contributions prohibited; legislature; governor

5 ~~A.~~ While registered under this article, a principal, public body,
6 lobbyist, designated public lobbyist or authorized public lobbyist shall
7 not make or promise to make a campaign contribution to or solicit or
8 promise to solicit campaign contributions for:

9 1. A member of the legislature ~~when the legislature is in regular~~
10 ~~session.~~

11 2. The governor ~~when the legislature is in regular session or when~~
12 ~~regular session legislation is pending executive approval or veto.~~

13 ~~B. Subsection A of this section only prohibits campaign~~
14 ~~contributions by principals, lobbyists, designated public lobbyists or~~
15 ~~authorized public lobbyists and the solicitation of campaign contributions~~
16 ~~by principals or lobbyists during any time that the legislature is in~~
17 ~~regular session but does not prohibit principals or lobbyists from raising~~
18 ~~monies for any other purpose during the regular session of the~~
19 ~~legislature.~~

20 ~~C. A member of the legislature or the governor may accept a~~
21 ~~campaign contribution that is received by a member of the legislature or~~
22 ~~the governor within three calendar days after the first day of the regular~~
23 ~~session of the legislature if the campaign contribution was mailed and~~
24 ~~postmarked before the first day of the regular legislative session.~~
