AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-701.04; RELATING TO INSTRUCTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 7, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-701.04, to read:

4 15-701.04. School districts; instructional time;
5 instructional hours; subject requirements

6 BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A SCHOOL
7 DISTRICT SHALL USE AT LEAST EIGHTY PERCENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL TIME OR
8 INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS EACH SCHOOL YEAR TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN THE AREAS
9 OF READING, WRITING, MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES.

11 This act may be cited as the "Back to Basics for Student Success
