AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 21.1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 36-2230; RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 21.1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2230, to read:

4 36-2230. Emergency administration of emergency contraception;
5 designation by director

6 A. A PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13 OR
7 17 OR A NURSE PRACTITIONER WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER
8 15 AND WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO PRESCRIBE DRUGS MAY ISSUE A STANDING
9 PRESCRIPTION DRUG ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DISPENSING OF EMERGENCY
10 CONTRACEPTION.

11 B. THE DIRECTOR SHALL DESIGNATE EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION THAT MAY BE
12 USED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION BASED ON AN EVALUATION OF THE EMERGENCY
13 CONTRACEPTION'S SAFETY AND EFFICACY.
