URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT THE STATE IMMIGRATION  
ENFORCEMENT ACT OR SIMILAR LEGISLATION.

1 To the Congress of the United States:

2 Your memorialist respectfully represents:

3 Whereas, the Biden Administration has consistently refused to  
4 enforce our nation's federal immigration laws; and

5 Whereas, this gross dereliction of duty has resulted in large  
6 numbers of illegal immigrants pouring over the United States southern  
7 border in what has become a historic invasion; and

8 Whereas, Congressman Andy Biggs of Arizona introduced legislation in  
9 Congress that would empower states and localities to pass and enforce  
10 their own immigration enforcement laws similar to federal immigration  
11 laws; and

12 Whereas, H.R. 9174, known as the State Immigration Enforcement Act,  
13 would allow states to bypass the current Administration's open border  
14 policies and restore the rule of law.

15 Wherefore your memorialist, the House of Representatives of the State of  
16 Arizona, the Senate concurring, prays:

17 1. That the United States Congress enact H.R. 9174, the State  
18 Immigration Enforcement Act, or similar legislation.

19 2. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit  
20 copies of this Memorial to the President of the United States, the  
21 President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States  
22 House of Representatives and each Member of Congress from the State of  
23 Arizona.
