HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2006

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IV, PART 2, SECTION 3, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 3, Constitution of Arizona, is
4 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 3. Sessions of legislature; special sessions; repeal
7 sessions; limitation of subjects for consideration

8 Section 3. The sessions of the legislature shall be
9 held annually at the capitol of the state, and shall commence
10 on the second Monday of January of each year. The governor
11 may call a special session, whenever in his judgment it is
12 advisable. In calling a special session, the governor shall
13 specify the subjects to be considered, and at such special
14 session no laws shall be enacted except such as relate to the
15 subjects mentioned in the call. A REPEAL SESSION SHALL BE
16 HELD ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS AT THE CAPITOL OF THE STATE AND
17 SHALL COMMENCE ON THE SECOND MONDAY IN OCTOBER OF EACH
18 ODD-NUMBERED YEAR. ONLY LEGISLATION REPEALING CURRENT LAWS
19 ENACTED THREE OR MORE YEARS BEFORE THE REPEAL SESSION, OR
20 PORTIONS THEREOF, SHALL BE CONSIDERED, ENACTED OR REFERRED TO
21 THE PEOPLE AT THE REPEAL SESSION.

22 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
23 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
24 Constitution of Arizona.
