## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENACTING AND ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE PEOPLE OF A MEASURE RELATING  
TO LOCATION OF COUNTIES.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,  
2 the Senate concurring:

3       1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the Legislature,  
4 the following measure, relating to location of counties, is enacted to  
5 become valid as a law if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the  
6 Governor:

## AN ACT

8 AMENDING SECTION 11-109, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING  
9 TITLE 11, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; BY  
10 ADDING SECTIONS 11-118, 11-119 AND 11-120; RELATING TO  
11 LOCATION OF COUNTIES.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

13                           Section 1. Section 11-109, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
14                           amended to read:

11-109. Maricopa county

16 Maricopa county, the county seat of which is Phoenix, is  
17 bounded as follows:

18                    Commencing at a point where the meridian line one  
19                    hundred thirteen degrees twenty minutes west longitude, as  
20                    defined by the Atwood survey of 1918, intersects the second  
21                    standard parallel south, being the northwest corner of Pima  
22                    county; thence north on such survey line and along the east  
23                    boundaries of Yuma and La Paz counties to the point where the  
24                    meridian line one hundred thirteen degrees twenty minutes west  
25                    longitude, as surveyed, intersects the thirty-fourth parallel  
26                    north latitude, as defined by the Thompson survey of 1924;  
27                    thence east on the thirty-fourth parallel north latitude, as  
28                    defined, and along the southern boundary of Yavapai county to  
29                    the point where the Hassayampa river intersects such parallel;  
30                    thence southeast in a direct line following the Thompson  
31                    survey of 1924 to a point in the Agua Fria river two miles  
32                    southerly and below the mouth of Humbug creek; thence  
33                    northerly up the Agua Fria river to a point two miles  
34                    southerly and below the place where the residence of J. W.  
35                    Swilling stood on January 31, 1877; thence easterly in a  
36                    direct line following the Thompson survey of 1924 to the point  
37                    where the thirty-fourth parallel north latitude, as defined by  
38                    such survey, intersects the Verde river; thence east on such  
39                    parallel to the point where the parallel as surveyed  
40                    intersects the summit of the Mazatzal range of mountains;  
41                    thence southerly along the summit of the Mazatzal range of  
42                    mountains to the point where such range of mountains  
43                    intersects the centerline of the Salt river; thence easterly  
44                    up the Salt river to the mouth of Tonto creek; thence  
45                    southerly in a direct line toward a mountain known as the

1           ~~"Water Shed," and along the western boundary of Gila county to~~  
2           ~~the point where such line and boundary intersects the north~~  
3           ~~line of township one north; thence west on the north line of~~  
4           ~~township one north and along the northern boundary of Pinal~~

6           ~~line of range seven east; thence south on the eastern line of~~  
7           ~~range seven east to the point where such line intersects the~~  
8           ~~southern line of township two south; thence west on such line~~

20          PINNACLE PEAK ROAD, THENCE EAST ALONG THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY  
21          OF GLENDALE; THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF  
22          GLENDALE TO THE POINT WHERE THE BOUNDARY INTERSECTS  
23          THUNDERBIRD ROAD; THENCE EAST ALONG THUNDERBIRD ROAD TO THE  
24          POINT WHERE THUNDERBIRD ROAD INTERSECTS CAVE CREEK ROAD;  
25          THENCE EAST FOLLOWING ALONG CACTUS ROAD TO THE POINT WHERE  
26          CACTUS ROAD INTERSECTS TATUM BOULEVARD; THENCE SOUTH ALONG  
27          TATUM BOULEVARD TO THE NORTHWEST BOUNDARY OF THE TOWN OF  
28          PARADISE VALLEY; THENCE SOUTH FOLLOWING THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF  
29          PHOENIX TO THE POINT WHERE THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF PHOENIX  
30          INTERSECTS THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF TEMPE ON  
31          MCDOWELL ROAD, THENCE SOUTH AND THENCE EAST FOLLOWING THE  
32          BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF TEMPE CONTINUING TO THE POINT WHERE  
33          THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF TEMPE INTERSECTS THE BOUNDARY OF  
34          THE CITY OF PHOENIX; THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE WESTERN BORDER OF  
35          THE CITY OF CHANDLER; THENCE EAST ALONG THE SOUTHERN BORDER OF  
36          THE CITY OF CHANDLER; THENCE SOUTH TO WHERE IT INTERSECTS THE  
37          MERIDIAN LINE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DEGREES TWENTY MINUTES WEST  
38          LONGITUDE; THENCE WEST ALONG THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF PINAL  
39          COUNTY TO THE POINT WHERE SUCH LINE INTERSECTS THE EASTERN  
40          LINE OF RANGE SEVEN EAST; THENCE SOUTH ON THE EASTERN LINE OF  
41          RANGE SEVEN EAST TO THE POINT WHERE SUCH LINE INTERSECTS THE  
42          SOUTHERN LINE OF TOWNSHIP TWO SOUTH; THENCE WEST ON SUCH LINE  
43          TO THE POINT WHERE SUCH LINE INTERSECTS THE GILA RIVER; THENCE  
44          NORTHERLY AND WESTERLY DOWN THE GILA RIVER TO THE POINT WHERE  
45          THE RIVER INTERSECTS THE EASTERN LINE OF RANGE ONE EAST, BEING

1 THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF PINAL COUNTY; THENCE SOUTH TO THE  
2 THIRTY-THIRD PARALLEL FOLLOWING A DIRECT LINE ALONG THE  
3 SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE GILA RIVER INDIAN RESERVATION; THENCE  
4 NORTH ALONG THE EASTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR;  
5 THENCE NORTH ALONG THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF  
6 AVONDALE TO WHERE INTERSECTS THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF  
7 GLENDALE; THENCE FOLLOWING THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF  
8 GLENDALE TO THE NORTHWESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE,  
9 WHICH IS THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

10 Sec. 2. Title 11, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised  
11 Statutes, is amended by adding sections 11-118, 11-119 and  
12 11-120, to read:

13       11-118. Hohokam county

14       HOHOKAM COUNTY IS BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:

15       SOUTH ON THE NORTHWESTERN POINT WHERE GILA COUNTY TO THE  
16 POINT WHERE SUCH LINE INTERSECTS THE SECOND STANDARD PARALLEL  
17 SOUTH, BEING THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF PINAL COUNTY; THENCE WEST  
18 ON SUCH PARALLEL TO THE POINT WHERE IT INTERSECTS THE MERIDIAN  
19 LINE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DEGREES TWENTY MINUTES WEST  
20 LONGITUDE TO THE WESTERN BORDER OF SUN LAKES AT PRICE ROAD;  
21 THENCE NORTH ALONG THE WESTERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER;  
22 THENCE WEST ALONG THE SOUTHERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER;  
23 THENCE NORTH ALONG THE WESTERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER;  
24 THENCE EAST ALONG THE NORTHERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER;  
25 THENCE NORTH ALONG THE BORDER OF THE CITY OF MESA CONTINUING  
26 TO THE NORTHWESTERN POINT WHERE GILA COUNTY INTERSECTS, WHICH  
27 IS THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

28       11-119. Mogollon county

29       MOGOLLON COUNTY IS BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:

30       COMMENCING AT THE AGUA FRIA RIVER TWO MILES SOUTHERLY  
31 AND BELOW THE MOUTH OF HUMBUG CREEK; THENCE NORtherly UP THE  
32 AGUA FRIA RIVER TO A POINT TWO MILES SOUTHERLY AND BELOW THE  
33 PLACE WHERE THE RESIDENCE OF J. W. SWILLING STOOD ON JANUARY  
34 31, 1877; THENCE EASTERLY IN A DIRECT LINE FOLLOWING THE  
35 THOMPSON SURVEY OF 1924 TO THE POINT WHERE THE THIRTY-FOURTH  
36 PARALLEL NORTH LATITUDE, AS DEFINED BY SUCH SURVEY, INTERSECTS  
37 THE VERDE RIVER; THENCE EAST ON SUCH PARALLEL TO THE POINT  
38 WHERE THE PARALLEL AS SURVEYED INTERSECTS THE SUMMIT OF THE  
39 MAZATZAL RANGE OF MOUNTAINS; THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE SUMMIT  
40 OF THE MAZATZAL RANGE OF MOUNTAINS TO THE POINT WHERE SUCH  
41 RANGE OF MOUNTAINS INTERSECTS THE CENTERLINE OF THE SALT  
42 RIVER; THENCE EASTERLY UP THE SALT RIVER TO THE MOUTH OF TONTO  
43 CREEK; THENCE SOUTHERLY IN A DIRECT LINE TOWARD A MOUNTAIN  
44 KNOWN AS THE "WATER SHED" AND ALONG THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF  
45 GILA COUNTY TO THE POINT WHERE SUCH LINE AND BOUNDARY

1           INTERSECTS THE NORTH LINE OF TOWNSHIP ONE NORTH; THENCE WEST  
2           FOLLOWING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF MESA TO THE  
3           SOUTHERN BORDER OF THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN  
4           RESERVATION TO THE BORDER OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE TO THE  
5           SOUTHERN BORDER OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY CONTINUING  
6           NORTHWARD TO THE NORTHWESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE  
7           VALLEY AT SHEA BOULEVARD AND TATUM BOULEVARD; THENCE NORTH  
8           FOLLOWING TATUM BOULEVARD TO CACTUS ROAD; THENCE WEST  
9           FOLLOWING CACTUS ROAD TO THE POINT WHERE CACTUS ROAD  
10          INTERSECTS CAVE CREEK ROAD; THENCE WEST FOLLOWING THUNDERBIRD  
11          ROAD TO THE POINT WHERE THUNDERBIRD ROAD INTERSECTS THE  
12          BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE; THENCE NORTH FOLLOWING THE  
13          EASTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE; THENCE NORTH  
14          FOLLOWING THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF PHOENIX; THENCE  
15          WEST FOLLOWING THE NORTHERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF PEORIA TO  
16          THE POINT ON THE AGUA FRIA RIVER, WHICH IS THE PLACE OF  
17          BEGINNING.

18          11-120. O'odham county

19          O'ODHAM COUNTY IS BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:

20          COMMENCING AT A POINT WHERE THE MERIDIAN LINE ONE  
21          HUNDRED THIRTEEN DEGREES TWENTY MINUTES WEST LONGITUDE, AS  
22          DEFINED BY THE ATWOOD SURVEY OF 1918, INTERSECTS THE SECOND  
23          STANDARD PARALLEL SOUTH, BEING THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF PIMA  
24          COUNTY; THENCE NORTH ON SUCH SURVEY LINE AND ALONG THE EAST  
25          BOUNDARIES OF YUMA AND LA PAZ COUNTIES TO THE POINT WHERE THE  
26          MERIDIAN LINE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN DEGREES TWENTY MINUTES WEST  
27          LONGITUDE, AS SURVEYED, INTERSECTS THE THIRTY-FOURTH PARALLEL  
28          NORTH LATITUDE, AS DEFINED BY THE THOMPSON SURVEY OF 1924;  
29          THENCE EAST ON THE THIRTY-FOURTH PARALLEL NORTH LATITUDE, AS  
30          DEFINED, AND ALONG THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF YAVAPAI COUNTY TO  
31          THE POINT WHERE THE HASSAYAMPA RIVER INTERSECTS SUCH PARALLEL;  
32          THENCE SOUTHEAST IN A DIRECT LINE FOLLOWING THE THOMPSON  
33          SURVEY OF 1924 TO THE THIRTY-FOURTH PARALLEL NORTH LATITUDE  
34          WHERE IT INTERSECTS THE BORDER OF THE CITY OF PEORIA  
35          BOUNDARIES; THENCE EAST FOLLOWING THE BORDER OF THE CITY OF  
36          PEORIA AND SOUTH FOLLOWING THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF PEORIA  
37          AND WEST ALONG NORTHERN AVENUE CONTINUING ALONG THE SOUTHERN  
38          BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF EL MIRAGE, THENCE NORTH ALONG THE  
39          BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF EL MIRAGE TO THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF  
40          THE CITY OF SURPRISE TO THE NORTHWESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY  
41          OF GLENDALE THENCE SOUTH FOLLOWING THE EASTERN BOUNDARY OF THE  
42          CITY OF GOODYEAR TO THE THIRTY-THIRD PARALLEL NORTH LATITUDE  
43          IN A DIRECT LINE TO THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE GILA RIVER  
44          INDIAN RESERVATION TO WHERE IT INTERSECTS THE BORDER OF PINAL  
45          COUNTY; THENCE SOUTH FOLLOWING THE BORDER OF PINAL COUNTY TO

1 WHERE IT INTERSECTS THE BORDER OF PIMA COUNTY; THEN WEST  
2 FOLLOWING THE NORTHERN BORDER OF PIMA COUNTY TO THE  
3 COMMENCEMENT POINT, WHICH IS THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

4 Sec. 3. Maricopa county division; procedures

5 A. Maricopa county operations shall continue in their  
6 existing form through a transition period of not more than  
7 three years after the effective date of this act. On the  
8 election of the boards of supervisors in Hohokam, Maricopa,  
9 Mogollon and O'odham counties, the existing Maricopa county  
10 operations shall continue under the supervision of the  
11 intercounty oversight and accountability board for the  
12 duration of the transition period. The current Maricopa  
13 county board of supervisors shall retain authority over the  
14 operation of Maricopa county during the transition period  
15 until the boards of supervisors in Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon  
16 and O'odham counties are sworn into office. The swearing in  
17 shall take place not later than June 15, 2024.

18 B. The boards of supervisors in Hohokam, Maricopa,  
19 Mogollon and O'odham counties shall be elected at a special  
20 election within one hundred twenty days after the effective  
21 date of this act. The supervisors shall be elected to  
22 staggered, abbreviated terms to serve until the next  
23 presidential election. Supervisors shall be elected at large  
24 for their initial terms and shall be elected by supervisorial  
25 district at subsequent elections. The board of supervisors  
26 shall approve supervisorial districts within one hundred  
27 eighty days after being sworn in.

28 C. Currently elected Maricopa county supervisors will  
29 continue in their elected capacities for the remainder of  
30 their terms. If a currently elected Maricopa county  
31 supervisor's supervisory district is located within Hohokam,  
32 Mogollon or O'odham counties, that supervisor will continue  
33 the supervisor's currently elected term in the new county in  
34 which the supervisory district is located.

35 D. The chairperson of each county's board of  
36 supervisors shall serve on an intercounty oversight and  
37 accountability board during the three-year transition period.  
38 The board shall make intercounty decisions and enter into  
39 mutually beneficial shared use or intergovernmental agreements  
40 for the continuation of services for Hohokam, Maricopa,  
41 Mogollon and O'odham counties. The board will terminate at  
42 the end of the transition period. The board may be continued  
43 if approved by a majority of the boards of supervisors of  
44 Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon and O'odham counties.

1           E. Control of existing special districts will be  
2 assumed by the county in which the special district is  
3 located. If a special district is located within more than  
4 one county, the counties shall enter into an intergovernmental  
5 agreement regarding control of the special district within one  
6 year after the election of the county board of supervisors.

7           F. The elected boards of supervisors in Hohokam,  
8 Mogollon and O'odham counties will determine an application  
9 process for municipalities to apply to be the county seat.  
10 The county seat shall be determined at a special election to  
11 take place not more than one hundred twenty days after the  
12 election of the boards of supervisors in Hohokam, Mogollon and  
13 O'odham counties.

14          G. Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon and O'odham counties may  
15 enter into a ten-year shared use agreement for the use of  
16 existing shared capital assets. The counties shall divide  
17 furniture, fixtures and equipment on a pro-rata basis based on  
18 the furniture, fixtures and equipment located in each county.

19          H. The election of unfilled elected county seats in  
20 Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon and O'odham counties shall take  
21 place at the same time as the election of the boards of  
22 supervisors in Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon and O'odham  
23 counties. Current elected officials shall finish their  
24 current terms in the county in which they reside.

25          I. Hohokam, Maricopa, Mogollon and O'odham counties  
26 shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the  
27 continued operation of community colleges for a period of not  
28 less than ten years after the effective date of this act.

29           Sec. 4. Conforming legislation

30          The legislative council staff shall prepare proposed  
31 legislation conforming the Arizona Revised Statutes to the  
32 provisions of this act for consideration in the fifty-seventh  
33 legislature, first regular session.

34          2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to  
35 the voters at the next general election as provided by article IV,  
36 part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona.
