2 Section 1. Section 13-2909, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 13-2909. Residential picketing; classification

5 A. A person commits residential picketing if, ~~with intent to~~
6 ~~harass, annoy or alarm another person, such~~ THE person intentionally
7 engages in picketing or otherwise demonstrates before or about ~~the AN~~
8 ~~INDIVIDUAL'S~~ residence or dwelling place ~~of an individual, other than a~~
9 ~~AND EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:~~

10 1. THE PERSON INTENDS THE PICKETING OR DEMONSTRATING TO HARASS,
11 ANNOY OR ALARM ANOTHER PERSON.

12 2. A REASONABLE PERSON WOULD FIND THE PERSON'S PICKETING OR
13 DEMONSTRATING TO BE HARASSING, ANNOYING OR ALARMING TO ANOTHER PERSON.

14 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A residence or dwelling place
15 THAT IS also used as the INDIVIDUAL'S principal place of business ~~of such~~
16 ~~individual~~.

17 ~~B.~~ C. Residential picketing is a class 3 misdemeanor.
