SENATE BILL 1024

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 15, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 28-913; RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 3, article 15, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 28-913, to read:

4 28-913. Prohibited use of public rights-of-way; exception

5 A. A PERSON MAY NOT ERECT OR MAINTAIN IN A PUBLIC STREET, HIGHWAY,
6 ALLEY, LANE, PARKWAY, SIDEWALK OR OTHER RIGHT-OF-WAY, WHETHER THE
7 RIGHT-OF-WAY IS DEDICATED TO THE PUBLIC IN FEE OR BY EASEMENT, ANY FULL OR
8 PARTIAL ENCLOSURE FOR HABITATION, INCLUDING A TENT, TARP, BOX OR SIMILAR
9 OBJECT.

10 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.
