# SENATE BILL 1066

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-146; RELATING TO REGISTRATION OFFICERS AND PROCEDURES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 1, article 3, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-146, to read:

4 16-146. Disclosure; third-party election mailings

5 A. ANY NONGOVERNMENTAL PERSON OR ENTITY THAT MAILS AN OFFICIAL  
6 ELECTION-RELATED DOCUMENT OR A DOCUMENT THAT RESEMBLES AN OFFICIAL  
7 ELECTION-RELATED DOCUMENT FROM THE COUNTY RECORDER OR COUNTY OFFICER IN  
8 CHARGE OF ELECTIONS OR THE SECRETARY OF STATE, INCLUDING A VOTER  
9 REGISTRATION APPLICATION OR AN EARLY BALLOT REQUEST, SHALL INCLUDE THE  
10 WORDS "NOT FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY" IN BOLDFACED, CLEARLY LEGIBLE PRINT  
11 ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE ENVELOPE.

12 B. FOR A DELIVERY BY MAIL OR BY HAND, THE DISCLOSURE SHALL BE  
13 DISPLAYED IN A HEIGHT THAT IS AT LEAST TEN PERCENT OF THE VERTICAL HEIGHT  
14 OF THE DOCUMENT.
