AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 16-821, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO POLITICAL PARTIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 16-821, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 16-821. County committee; vacancy in office of precinct
5 committeeman

6 A. At the primary election, the members of a political party
7 entitled to representation pursuant to section 16-804 residing in each
8 precinct shall choose one of their number as a county precinct
9 committeeman, and the members shall choose one additional precinct
10 committeeman for each one hundred twenty-five voters or major fraction
11 thereof registered in the party in the precinct as reported pursuant to
12 section 16-168, subsection G on January 2 of the year in which the general
13 election is held. The whole number of precinct committeemen of a
14 political party shall constitute the county committee of the party.

15 B. The board of supervisors, ~~upon~~ ON the recommendation of the
16 county ~~chairman~~, CHAIRPERSON or the recommendation of a committee
17 designated in the bylaws of the county committee for that purpose, shall
18 determine when a vacancy exists in the office of precinct
19 committeeman. If a vacancy exists, the vacancy shall be filled by the
20 board of supervisors from a list of names submitted by the county ~~chairman~~
21 CHAIRPERSON of the appropriate political party. Only a precinct
22 committeeman elected at the primary election prior to the date of a state
23 or county committee organizing meeting shall be ~~permitted~~ ALLOWED to vote
24 at such meeting. The criteria used to establish when a vacancy exists in
25 the office of precinct committeeman shall be as established in section
26 38-291.
