AMENDING TITLE 39, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 39-129; RELATING TO PUBLIC RECORDS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 39, chapter 1, article 2, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 39-129, to read:

4 39-129. Local law enforcement; video recordings; fee

5 A CITY OR TOWN MAY ESTABLISH A FEE THAT IS CHARGED TO A PERSON WHO
6 SUBMITS A PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST TO A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR A
7 COPY OF A VIDEO RECORDING. A CITY OR TOWN MAY TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE
8 FOLLOWING INFORMATION WHEN DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE:

- 9 1. THE COST OF REVIEWING, STORING, MAKING A COPY OF AND, AS
10 NECESSARY, REDACTING THE VIDEO RECORDING.
11 2. THE HOURLY COMPENSATION OF A PUBLIC RECORDS EMPLOYEE.
12 3. ANY OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION.
