AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 25-1004, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CHILD CUSTODY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 25-1004, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 25-1004. Application to Indian tribes

5 A. A child custody proceeding that pertains to an Indian child as
6 defined in the Indian child welfare act OF 1978 (25 United States Code
7 section 1903) is not subject to this chapter to the extent that it is
8 governed by the Indian child welfare act OF 1978.

9 B. A court of this state shall treat a tribe as if it were a state
10 of the United States for the purpose of applying this article and article
11 2 of this chapter.

12 C. A child custody determination made by a tribe under factual
13 circumstances in substantial conformity with the jurisdictional standards
14 of this chapter must be recognized and enforced under article 3 of this
15 chapter.
