AMENDING SECTION 38-296, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VACANCY IN OFFICE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 38-296, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 38-296. Limitation on filing for election by incumbent of
5 elective office

6 A. ~~Except during the final year of the term being served, no AN~~ An
7 incumbent of a salaried elective office, whether holding by election or
8 appointment, may NOT offer himself for nomination or election to any
9 salaried local, state or federal office.

10 B. An incumbent of a salaried elected office shall be deemed to
11 have offered himself for nomination or election to a salaried local, state
12 or federal office on ~~the~~ the filing of a nomination paper pursuant to section
13 16-311, subsection A. An incumbent of a salaried elected office is not
14 deemed to have offered himself for nomination or election to an office by
15 making a formal declaration of candidacy for the office. **AN INCUMBENT OF**
A SALARIED ELECTED OFFICE MUST RESIGN WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER FILING A
NOMINATION PAPER PURSUANT TO SECTION 16-311, SUBSECTION A.

16 C. The resignation of the incumbent elective officer duly filed in
17 writing with the officer, board or commission having jurisdiction of the
18 office, if not accepted within ten days, shall be deemed to have become
19 effective as of the date of filing.

20 D. This section ~~shall not be construed to~~ DOES NOT prohibit a
21 person whose resignation from office has become effective from qualifying
22 as a candidate for another office during the unexpired portion of the term
23 affected by the resignation, nor ~~shall~~ DOES it apply to any incumbent
24 elective officer who seeks reelection to the same office ~~or to any other~~
25 ~~public office~~ during the final year of the term to which the person has
26 been so elected.

27 E. A person violating ~~any provision of~~ this section is guilty of
28 misfeasance in office, and the office held by such person shall be
29 declared vacant.
