# **SB 1260**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 43-1711, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS INCOME TAX.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2       Section 1. Section 43-1711, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4           43-1711. Taxes and tax rate

5       If an Arizona small business taxpayer makes the election pursuant to  
6 section 43-302, there shall be levied, collected and paid for each taxable  
7 year on the Arizona small business taxable income taxes as determined in  
8 the following manner:

9           1. For taxable years beginning from and after December 31, 2020  
10 through December 31, 2021, an amount equal to 3.5% of the Arizona small  
11 business taxable income.

12           2. For taxable years beginning from and after December 31, 2021  
13 through December 31, 2022, an amount equal to 3.0% of the Arizona small  
14 business taxable income.

15           3. For taxable years beginning from and after December 31, 2022  
16 ~~through December 31, 2024, an amount equal to 2.8% of the Arizona small~~  
17 ~~business taxable income.~~

18           4. 3. For taxable years beginning from and after December 31,  
19 ~~2024~~ 2022, an amount equal to 2.5% of the Arizona small business taxable  
20 income.

21           Sec. 2. Retroactivity

22       This act applies retroactively to taxable years beginning from and  
23 after December 31, 2022.
