AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE ON TRIBAL RELATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; governor's office on tribal
3 relations; flooding and water control; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$8,000,000 is appropriated from the state general
5 fund in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the governor's office on tribal relations
6 to distribute to the San Carlos Apache tribe to conduct a feasibility
7 study and conduct environmental clearances to address flooding and water
8 control impacting the tribe.

9 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
10 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
11 to lapsing of appropriations.
