AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-924, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VEHICLE EQUIPMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 28-924, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-924. Motor vehicle head lamps

5 A. A motor vehicle other than a motorcycle, an all-terrain vehicle
6 or a motor driven cycle shall be equipped with at least two head lamps
7 with at least one on each side of the front of the motor vehicle. The
8 head lamps shall comply with the requirements and limitations of this
9 article.

10 B. A motorcycle, an all-terrain vehicle and a motor driven cycle
11 shall be equipped with at least one and not more than two head lamps that
12 comply with the requirements and limitations of this article.

13 C. A head lamp on a motor vehicle, including a motorcycle, an
14 all-terrain vehicle and a motor driven cycle, shall be located at a height
15 of not more than fifty-four inches nor less than twenty-two inches to be
16 measured as provided in section 28-923, subsection B.

17 D. A MOTOR VEHICLE, INCLUDING A MOTORCYCLE, AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE
18 AND A MOTOR DRIVEN CYCLE, MAY NOT BE EQUIPPED WITH A XENON GAS BULB OR A
19 HIGH-INTENSITY DISCHARGE LIGHT-EMITTING DIODE HEAD LAMP. THIS SUBSECTION
20 APPLIES TO A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN IT IS MANUFACTURED AND TO AFTERMARKET
21 MOTOR VEHICLE PRODUCTS.
