AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-975, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE AND LOCAL ASSISTANCE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND ACCOMMODATION SCHOOLS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-975, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-975. Method of determining funds payable to a joint common
5 school district

6 In determining the amount of state, county and federal monies or
7 school aid payable to a joint common school district, the portion of the
8 territory of the joint common school district within each county shall be
9 regarded as a separate school district lying within ~~such~~ THE county.
10 Records of student count shall be kept ~~as~~ to make readily ascertainable
11 the attendance of pupils residing in the portion of the school district in
12 each county. The forms and reports required by law to be filed shall be
13 appropriately filed. Student enrollment and attendance information
14 required by this subsection shall be submitted electronically to the
15 superintendent of public instruction ~~in a format provided~~. For purposes
16 of applying to a joint common school district the provisions of section
17 15-101, "assessed valuation" means the net valuation of the part of the
18 school district in the county, and the part of the school district in each
19 county shall be regarded as a school district employing five or more
20 contract classroom teachers.
