AMENDING SECTION 1-304, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 1-304, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 1-304. Arbor day; proclamation

5 A. The last Friday in April, in each year, shall be known as Arbor  
6 Day.

7 B. The governor shall make proclamation of Arbor Day and recommend  
8 that it be observed in planting trees, shrubs and vines, in the promotion  
9 of forest orchard growth and culture, in the adornment of public and  
10 private grounds, places and ways and in other undertakings in harmony with  
11 the character of the day.

12 C. Arbor Day ~~shall~~ IS not ~~be~~ a legal holiday.
