### A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF LOCAL REVENUES BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN  
EXCESS OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL EXPENDITURE LIMITATION IN FISCAL YEAR  
2022-2023.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of  
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. That the legislature authorizes the expenditure of local  
4 revenues by school districts in excess of the expenditure limitation  
5 prescribed pursuant to article IX, section 21, Constitution of Arizona, in  
6 fiscal year 2022-2023.

7 2. That the authorization provided by paragraph 1 of this  
8 resolution is effective only on the approval of this resolution by at  
9 least two-thirds of the membership of each house of the legislature by  
10 roll call vote on or before March 1, 2023.
