HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2418

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Page 1, line 4, after "requirements" insert "; reporting requirements; review"

2 Line 6, strike the second "TO" insert "OF AN AVERAGE OF FIVE MINUTES OVER A
3 TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD FOR"

4 Line 7, strike "OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE MINUTES"

5 Line 9, after "PROCEDURES" insert "FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE
6 TIMES"; after "THAT" strike remainder of line

7 Strike lines 10 through 15, insert "CITIES AND TOWNS MUST FOLLOW FOR
8 CALCULATING LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIMES AND TRACKING AND
9 REPORTING THE CITIES' AND TOWNS' COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT
10 EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIME REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A OF
11 THIS SECTION. THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MUST DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

12 1. DEFINE EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIME AND LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY
13 CALL.

14 2. OUTLINE THE METHODS AND DATA SOURCES CITIES AND TOWNS MUST USE TO
15 CALCULATE LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIMES.

16 3. SPECIFY THE FORMAT REQUIRED FOR SUBMITTING THE INFORMATION
17 REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION.

18 C. ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH CITY AND TOWN SHALL
19 ANNUALLY SUBMIT TO THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION THE FOLLOWING
20 INFORMATION FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR:

21 1. THE COMPLIANCE RATE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN
22 SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

23 2. THE AVERAGE LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIME FOR THE
24 CITY OR TOWN.

1 3. THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF LAW ENFORCEMENT PATROL OFFICERS PER LAW
2 ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL.

3 D. ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE
4 COMMISSION SHALL COMPILE AND PUBLISH THE INFORMATION SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO
5 SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION AND POST THE INFORMATION ON THE ARIZONA
6 CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION'S WEBSITE.

7 E. THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION SHALL ANNUALLY SELECT A
8 SAMPLE OF AT LEAST TEN PERCENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS TO REVIEW COMPLIANCE
9 WITH THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIME POLICIES AND PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED
10 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL REVIEW THE ACCURACY OF
11 THE DATA USED TO CALCULATE THE INFORMATION SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
12 C OF THIS SECTION.

13 F. ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE REVIEW, THE
14 ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION SHALL POST THE RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL
15 REVIEW PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION E OF THIS SECTION ON ITS WEBSITE.

16 G. IF A CITY'S OR TOWN'S AVERAGE ANNUAL LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY
17 CALL RESPONSE TIME EXCEEDS FIVE MINUTES, THE CITY OR TOWN, WITHIN SIXTY
18 DAYS, SHALL DEVELOP AN ACTION PLAN TO MEET THE RESPONSE TIME REQUIREMENTS
19 PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. IF THE CITY OR TOWN IS NOT IN
20 COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIME
21 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION WITHIN TWO YEARS, THE CITY OR
22 TOWN SHALL SEND WRITTEN NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OR TOWN. THE
23 WRITTEN NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION ON THE RESPONSE TIME FOR LAW
24 ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALLS FOR THE PREVIOUS TWO-YEAR PERIOD AND THAT THE
25 CITY OR TOWN HAS NOT MET THE LAW ENFORCEMENT EMERGENCY CALL RESPONSE TIME
26 REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. IF A CITY OR TOWN
27 IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION WITHIN A
28 THREE-YEAR PERIOD, THE CITY OR TOWN IS CONSIDERED TO BE IN VIOLATION OF
29 THIS SECTION."

6 15. ANNUALLY COMPILE AND PUBLISH ON THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE
7 COMMISSION'S WEBSITE INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM CITIES AND TOWNS PURSUANT TO
8 SECTION 9-500.49.

9 16. PERFORM AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF AT LEAST TEN PERCENT OF CITIES AND
10 TOWNS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 9-500.49 AND POST THE ANNUAL REVIEW
11 OF THE REPORT ON THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION'S WEBSITE."

12 After line 36, insert:

13 "Sec. 3. Appropriation; Arizona criminal justice commission;
14 law enforcement emergency response time review

15 A. The sum of \$500,000 and six FTE positions are appropriated from
16 the state general fund in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the Arizona criminal
17 justice commission to perform a review of law enforcement emergency call
18 response times pursuant to section 9-500.49, Arizona Revised Statutes, as
19 added by this act.

20 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
21 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
22 to lapsing of appropriations."
