HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.C.R. 2006

(Reference to printed resolution)

1 Strike everything after the resolving clause and insert:

2 "1. Article IV, part 2, section 3, Constitution of Arizona, is
3 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on
4 proclamation of the Governor:

5 3. Sessions of legislature; special sessions; repeal
6 sessions; limitation of subjects for consideration

7 Section 3. The sessions of the legislature shall be held
8 annually at the capitol of the state, and shall commence on the
9 second Monday of January of each year. The governor may call a
10 special session, whenever in his judgment it is advisable. In
11 calling a special session, the governor shall specify the subjects to
12 be considered, and at such special session no laws shall be enacted
13 except such as relate to the subjects mentioned in the call. A REPEAL
14 SESSION SHALL BE HELD ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS AT THE CAPITOL OF THE
15 STATE, AND SHALL COMMENCE ON THE SECOND MONDAY IN OCTOBER OF EACH ODD
16 NUMBERED YEAR. ONLY LEGISLATION REPEALING CURRENT LAWS, OR PORTIONS
17 THEREOF, SHALL BE CONSIDERED, ENACTED OR REFERRED TO THE PEOPLE AT
18 THE REPEAL SESSION.

- 1 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters at
- 2 the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of Arizona."
