SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1657

1 Page 2, line 7, after "1." insert "SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE STATE BOARD OF  
2 EDUCATION,"

3 Line 9, after the period insert "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 15-763,"

4 Page 6, between lines 9 and 10, insert:

5 "Sec. 3. Section 15-763, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
6 read:

7       15-763. Plan for providing special education; definition

8           A. All school districts and charter schools shall develop policies  
9       and procedures for providing special education to all children with  
10      disabilities within the district or charter school. All children with  
11      disabilities shall receive special education programming commensurate with  
12      their abilities and needs. Each child **WITH A DISABILITY** shall be ensured  
13      access to the general curriculum and an opportunity to meet the state's  
14      academic standards. If appropriate to meet the needs of a pupil and to  
15      ensure access to the general education curriculum, specially designed  
16      instruction that is in accordance with a pupil's individualized education  
17      program may be delivered in a variety of education settings by a general  
18      education teacher or other certificated personnel provided that special  
19      education personnel certificated pursuant to section 15-203 are involved in  
20      the planning, progress monitoring and, when appropriate, ~~involved in the~~  
21      delivery of the specially designed instruction. **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION**  
22      **15-701.01, SUBSECTION B,** pupils who receive special education ~~shall~~ ARE not  
23      ~~be~~ required to achieve passing scores on the statewide assessment or the  
24      test that is identical to the civics portion of the naturalization test  
25      under section 15-701.01 in order to graduate from high school unless the  
26      pupil is learning at a level appropriate for the pupil's grade level in a  
27      specific academic area and unless a passing score on the statewide  
28      assessment or the test that is identical to the civics portion of the

1       naturalization test under section 15-701.01 is specifically required in a  
2       specific academic area by the pupil's individualized education program as  
3       mutually agreed on by the pupil's parents and the pupil's individualized  
4       education program team or the pupil, if the pupil is at least eighteen  
5       years of age. The pupil's individualized education program shall include  
6       any necessary testing accommodations. Special education services shall be  
7       provided at no cost to the parents of children with disabilities.

8              B. The state board of education shall adopt guidelines to define a  
9       parent's or guardian's role or a pupil's role, if the pupil is at least  
10       eighteen years of age, in the development of a pupil's section 504 plan as  
11       defined in section 15-731, including testing and testing accommodations.

12              C. For the purposes of determining the services to pupils served by  
13       private schools under existing federal law, the state shall consider the  
14       term to include homeschooled pupils.

15              D. If federal monies are provided to a school district or a charter  
16       school for special education services to homeschooled or private schooled  
17       pupils, the school district or charter school shall provide the services to  
18       both the homeschooled pupils and the private schooled pupils in the same  
19       manner.

20              E. For the purposes of this section, "special education" has the  
21       same meaning prescribed in section 15-1201."
