5 A. The following amounts are appropriated in the following fiscal
6 years from the consumer remediation subaccount of the consumer restitution
7 and remediation revolving fund established by section 44-1531.02, Arizona
8 Revised Statutes, to the gang and immigration intelligence team enforcement
9 mission fund established by section 41-1724, Arizona Revised Statutes, as
10 amended by this act:

- 11 1. \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2024-2025.
- 12 2. \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2025-2026.

13 B. The following amounts are appropriated in the following fiscal
14 years from the gang and immigration intelligence team enforcement mission
15 fund established by section 41-1724, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended
16 by this act, to the department of public safety to establish and maintain a
17 southern Arizona counterterrorism information center:

- 18 1. \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2024-2025.
- 19 2. \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2025-2026.

1 C. The appropriations made in subsections A and B of this section
2 are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 relating to lapsing of appropriations."
