## **HOUSE BILL 2271**

## AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2351 AND 28-2403, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 12, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-2470.23; AMENDING SECTIONS 28-6501, 28-6991 AND 28-6993, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 3 read:

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28-2351. License plate provided; design

A. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall provide to every owner one license plate for each vehicle registered. At the request of the owner and on payment of a fee in an amount prescribed by the director by rule, the department shall provide one additional license plate for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested pursuant to this chapter.

B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the 11 12 vehicle and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which 13 may be abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a 14 reflective material that is consistent with the determination of the 15 department regarding the color and design of license plates and special plates. The director shall design the license plate and the letters and 16 17 numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly 18 readable during daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition 19 to the standard license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005, 20 the director shall issue a license plate for trailers that has a design 21 that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that 22 is the same size as the license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner 23 shall notify the department which size license plate the owner wants for 24 the trailer.

25 C. In addition to the requirements PRESCRIBED in subsection B of 26 this section, for all license plates, including all special plates, that 27 are designed or redesigned on or after September 24, 2022:

The background color of the license plate shall contrast
 significantly with the color of the letters and numerals on the license
 plate and with the name of this state on the license plate.

2. The name of this state shall appear on the license plate in capital letters in sans serif font and be three-fourths of an inch in height.

D. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract with a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many individual responsible respondents as possible.

39 E. The department shall determine the color and design of the 40 license plate subject to the requirements prescribed by subsections B and C of this section. All plates issued by the department, except the plates 41 42 that are issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414, 43 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through <del>28-2470.22</del> 28-2470.23, 28-2472, 44 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475, 28-2476 and 28-4533 and article 14 of this 45 chapter, shall be the same color as and similar in design to the license 46 plate as determined by the department.

F. A passenger motor vehicle that is rented without a driver shall receive the same type of license plate as is issued for a private passenger motor vehicle.

4 Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 5 read:

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28-2403. Special plates; transfers; violation; classification

A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates are met:

12 1. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, a person 13 who is the registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or 14 who applies for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may 15 submit to the department a completed application form as prescribed by the 16 department with the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates 17 in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

18 2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 19 28-2413. 28-2414. 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through <del>28-2470.22</del> 20 28-2470.23, 28-2472, 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475 and 28-2476 and article 14 21 of this chapter, the special plates shall be the same color as and similar 22 to the design of the regular license plates that is determined by the department. 23

3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall issue special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is currently registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross weight, as defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or less.

4. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, the department shall charge the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each annual renewal of special plates in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

33 B. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, on notification to the department and on payment of the transfer fee 34 35 prescribed by section 28-2402, a person who is issued special plates may transfer the special plates to another vehicle the person owns or leases. 36 37 Persons who are issued special plates for hearing impaired persons pursuant to section 28-2408 and international symbol of access special 38 plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are exempt from the transfer fee. If a 39 40 person who is issued special plates sells, trades or otherwise releases ownership of the vehicle on which the plates have been displayed, the 41 42 person shall immediately report the transfer of the plates to the department or the person shall surrender the plates to the department as 43 44 prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to whom the 45 plates have been issued to knowingly allow them to be displayed on a 46 vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.

1 C. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which 2 registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates. 3 D. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who: 4 1. Violates subsection B of this section. 5 2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the 6 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant 7 to this article. 8 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the 9 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant 10 to this article. Sec. 3. THE PERSON THAT 18 PROVIDES THE \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION 19 SPECIAL PLATES. E. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE MONIES FROM THE FUND TO AN

INTERNAL REVENUE CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES AND THAT HAS
FINANCIAL OVERSIGHT OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING'S ALUMNI CHAPTERS

IN THIS STATE. THE ENTITY MAY USE THE MONIES ONLY FOR ALUMNI PROGRAMS IN 1 2 THIS STATE AND FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND REPLENISHMENT GRANTS FOR STUDENTS WHO 3 ARE RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE AND WHO ARE ATTENDING AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 4 LEARNING. Section 28-6991, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 29 30 read: 31 28-6991. State highway fund; sources 32 The state highway fund is established that consists of: 1. Monies distributed from the Arizona highway user revenue fund 33 34 pursuant to chapter 18 of this title. 35 2. Monies appropriated by the legislature. 3. Monies received from donations for the construction, improvement 36 37 or maintenance of state highways or bridges. These monies shall be credited to a special account and shall be spent only for the purpose 38 39 indicated by the donor. 40 4. Monies received from counties or cities under cooperative agreements, including proceeds from bond issues. The state treasurer 41 42 shall deposit these monies to the credit of the fund in a special account 43 on delivery to the treasurer of a concise written agreement between the 44 department and the county or city stating the purposes for which the monies are surrendered by the county or city, and these monies shall be 45 46 spent only as stated in the agreement.

(c) Constructing, maintaining and upgrading transportation
 facilities, including roads, streets and highways, approved by the board
 within twenty-five miles of the border between this state and Mexico.

30 (d) As approved by the board, constructing and maintaining 31 transportation facilities in the CANAMEX high priority corridor as defined 32 in section 332 of the national highway system designation act of 1995 33 (P.L. 104-59; 109 Stat. 568).

34 (e) Activities of the department that include collecting 35 transportation and trade data in the United States and Mexico for the 36 purposes of constructing transportation facilities, improving public 37 safety, improving truck processing time and relieving congestion at ports 38 of entry on the border between this state and Mexico. The department may enter into an agreement with the Arizona-Mexico commission and provide 39 40 funding to the commission for the purposes of this subdivision.

41 (f) A commitment or investment necessary for the department or 42 another agency of this state to obtain federal monies that are designated 43 for expenditure pursuant to this section.

B. For each fiscal year, the department of transportation shall allocate and transfer monies in the state highway fund to the department of public safety for funding a portion of highway patrol costs in eight 1 installments in each of the first eight months of a fiscal year that do 2 not exceed \$10,000,000.

C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the department may use the 3 4 monies in the state highway fund as prescribed in section 28-6991, 5 paragraph 12 to carry out the duties imposed by this title for 6 registration or titling of vehicles, to operate joint title, registration 7 and driver licensing offices, to cover the administrative costs of issuing 8 the air quality compliance sticker, modifying the year validating tab and 9 issuing the windshield sticker and to cover expenses and costs in issuing 10 special plates pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2407, 28-2412 through 28-2470.22 28-2470.23 and 28-2514. 11

12 D. The department shall use monies deposited in the state highway 13 fund pursuant to chapter 5, article 5 of this title only as prescribed by 14 that article.

15 E. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section 16 28-2269 shall be used only as prescribed by that section.

F. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section 8 28-710, subsection D, paragraph 2 shall only be used for state highway 9 work zone traffic control devices.

20 G. The department may exchange monies distributed to the state 21 highway fund pursuant to section 28-6538, subsection A, paragraph 1 for 22 local government surface transportation program federal monies 23 suballocated to councils of government and metropolitan planning 24 organizations if the local government scheduled to receive the federal 25 monies concurs. An exchange of state highway fund monies pursuant to this subsection shall be in an amount that is at least equal to ninety percent 26 27 of the federal obligation authority that exists in the project for which 28 the exchange is proposed.

H. The department shall use monies deposited in the state highway 29 30 fund pursuant to section 28-1105, subsection A, paragraph 2, subdivision (a) only for a transportation facility that is located within twenty 31 32 drivable miles of the international port of entry and shall spend the 33 monies proportionally based on the amount of total monies collected pursuant to section 28-1105, subsection A, paragraph 2, subdivision (a). 34 35 For the purposes of this subsection, "transportation facility" means a 36 highway or a state route or a county, city or town road that is used by a 37 commercial vehicle or a commercial vehicle combination for which an axle 38 fee is paid pursuant to section 28-5474.
