AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 11-622, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CLAIMS AND WARRANTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 11-622, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 11-622. Demand; time limit for presentation of claim

5 A. A person having a claim against a county shall present to the
6 board of supervisors of the county against which the demand is held an
7 itemized claim executed by the person under penalties of perjury, stating
8 minutely what the claim is for, specifying each item, the date and amount
9 of each item and stating that the claim and each item of the claim ~~is~~ ARE
10 justly due.

11 B. Sellers of goods or services to a county may submit claims in
12 writing or by electronic data interchange if such method is approved by
13 the county board of supervisors. All other claims shall be submitted in
14 writing.

15 C. The board of supervisors shall not pay any claim unless demand
16 for payment is made within six months after the last item of the account
17 accrues.
