AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A MOBILE COMMUNICATIONS PLATFORM FOR ELECTION WORKERS;
APPROPRIATING MONIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Election worker communications platform; pilot
3 program; appropriation; delayed repeal

4 A. The secretary of state in cooperation and consultation with
5 county recorders and election officers shall establish an election worker
6 communications platform that is suitable for mobile application and use by
7 election administrators and election workers, including poll workers,
8 drivers, warehouse and supply workers, voter registration workers and
9 central count center workers.

10 B. The election worker communications platform shall be deployed in
11 a pilot program in one or more counties or other jurisdictions or portions
12 of counties or jurisdictions. The secretary of state may offer use of the
13 platform to counties at reduced or no cost.

14 C. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
15 in fiscal year 2024-2025 to the secretary of state for the purposes of
16 this act.

17 D. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2025.
