AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 31, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-3123; RELATING TO WEAPONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 31, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 13-3123, to read:

4 13-3123. Armed repeat offenders; classification; definition

5 A. A PERSON IS AN ARMED REPEAT OFFENDER IF THE PERSON COMMITS
6 MISCONDUCT INVOLVING WEAPONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 13-3102, SUBSECTION A,
7 PARAGRAPH 4 AND THE PERSON BOTH:

8 1. HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF THREE OR MORE HISTORICAL PRIOR FELONY
9 CONVICTIONS ON THREE SEPARATE DATES.

10 2. HAS SERVED PRIOR PRISON TIME.

11 B. A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A CLASS 2 FELONY.

12 C. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "HISTORICAL PRIOR FELONY
13 CONVICTION" INCLUDES ANY OFFENSE COMMITTED OUTSIDE THIS STATE THAT IF
14 COMMITTED IN THIS STATE WOULD CONSTITUTE A CLASS 1, 2, 3 OR 4 FELONY.
