AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-701.04; RELATING TO SCHOOL CURRICULA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 7, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-701.04, to read:

4 15-701.04. Guidelines; policies; high schools; foster
5 children; transfer credits; graduation
6 requirements; educational record; definitions

7 A. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR
8 CHARTER SCHOOLS AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO CONSIDER WHEN DEVELOPING POLICIES
9 REGARDING THE CALCULATION OF ACADEMIC CREDITS, INCLUDING PARTIAL CREDITS,
10 FOR FOSTER CHILDREN WHO TRANSFER SCHOOLS PURSUANT TO A BEST INTEREST
11 EDUCATIONAL PLACEMENT DETERMINATION WHILE THE FOSTER CHILD IS ENROLLED IN
12 ANY OF GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE. THE GUIDELINES DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO
13 THIS SUBSECTION MUST INCLUDE ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR A RECEIVING SCHOOL TO
14 CALCULATE AND ACCEPT ACADEMIC CREDITS, INCLUDING PARTIAL CREDITS, THAT
15 WERE EARNED BY A FOSTER CHILD IN THE FOSTER CHILD'S SCHOOL OF ORIGIN.

16 B. EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD AND CHARTER SCHOOL
17 GOVERNING BODY SHALL DEVELOP AND ADOPT POLICIES CONCERNING TRANSFER
18 CREDITS FOR FOSTER CHILDREN WHO TRANSFER TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER
19 SCHOOL PURSUANT TO A BEST INTEREST EDUCATIONAL PLACEMENT DETERMINATION
20 WHILE THE FOSTER CHILD IS ENROLLED IN ANY OF GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE.
21 THE POLICIES ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION MUST SPECIFY THE MANNER
22 IN WHICH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL WILL:

23 1. CALCULATE FULL AND PARTIAL ACADEMIC CREDITS THAT WERE EARNED BY
24 THE FOSTER CHILD AT THE FOSTER CHILD'S SCHOOL OF ORIGIN.

25 2. ACCEPT ALL ACADEMIC CREDITS, INCLUDING PARTIAL CREDITS, EARNED
26 BY THE FOSTER CHILD IN COURSES OR INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS AT THE FOSTER
27 CHILD'S SCHOOL OF ORIGIN.

28 3. DETERMINE WHETHER TO ACCEPT ACADEMIC CREDITS, INCLUDING PARTIAL
29 CREDITS, EARNED BY THE FOSTER CHILD AS CORE CREDITS OR AS ELECTIVE
30 CREDITS. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL MAKE EVERY POSSIBLE
31 ATTEMPT TO ACCEPT AS CORE CREDITS ALL ACADEMIC CREDITS EARNED BY THE
32 FOSTER CHILD AND SHALL CONSIDER EACH LEARNING OUTCOME THAT THE FOSTER
33 CHILD HAS MASTERED AND EACH COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT THAT THE FOSTER CHILD
34 HAS DEMONSTRATED.

35 4. MEET WITH THE FOSTER CHILD NOT LATER THAN TEN DAYS AFTER THE
36 FOSTER CHILD ENROLLS IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL TO REVIEW
37 AND UPDATE THE FOSTER CHILD'S GRADUATION PLAN, INCLUDING THE FOSTER
38 CHILD'S PARTICIPATION IN CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAMS, IF NECESSARY. THE
39 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE A WRITTEN COPY OF THE
40 GRADUATION PLAN TO THE FOSTER CHILD, EACH PARENT OF THE FOSTER CHILD WHOSE
41 PARENTAL RIGHTS HAVE NOT BEEN TERMINATED AND THE FOSTER CHILD'S GUARDIAN,
42 CUSTODIAN, CAREGIVER OR FOSTER PARENT.

43 C. EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD AND CHARTER SCHOOL
44 GOVERNING BODY SHALL DEVELOP AND ADOPT POLICIES CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF
45 EDUCATIONAL RECORDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 8-530.04 BY THE SCHOOL OF ORIGIN

1 FOR A FOSTER CHILD WHO WAS ENROLLED IN ANY OF GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE.
2 THE POLICIES ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION MUST REQUIRE THE SCHOOL
3 OF ORIGIN TO INCLUDE IN THE FOSTER CHILD'S EDUCATIONAL RECORDS ALL OF THE
4 FOLLOWING:
5 1. ALL ACADEMIC CREDITS, INCLUDING PARTIAL CREDITS, EARNED BY THE
6 FOSTER CHILD.
7 2. EACH LEARNING OUTCOME THAT THE FOSTER CHILD MASTERED.
8 3. A RECORD OF THE FOSTER CHILD'S DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCIES,
9 COMPLETED COURSEWORK AND EXAMINATIONS.
10 D. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 15-701.01 AND 15-720.02, A CHARTER
11 SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY OR SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE A
12 FOSTER CHILD WHO TRANSFERS SCHOOLS PURSUANT TO A BEST INTEREST EDUCATIONAL
13 PLACEMENT DETERMINATION TO SATISFY A COURSE OF STUDY OR COMPETENCY
14 REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL THAT ARE IN ADDITION TO OR
15 HIGHER THAN THE MINIMUM COURSE OF STUDY AND COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS
16 PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
17 E. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:
18 1. "BEST INTEREST EDUCATIONAL PLACEMENT DETERMINATION" MEANS THE
19 DETERMINATION OF A CHILD'S BEST INTEREST EDUCATIONAL PLACEMENT PURSUANT TO
20 SECTION 8-530.04.
21 2. "FOSTER CHILD" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 8-501.
