AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 20-3103; RELATING TO HEALTH CARE INSURANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 20, chapter 20, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 20-3103, to read:

4 20-3103. Denial of claims; health care provider review;
5 unprofessional conduct; definition

6 A. A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER SHALL INDIVIDUALLY REVIEW EACH CLAIM FOR
7 HEALTH CARE SERVICES BEFORE A HEALTH CARE INSURER DENIES THE CLAIM.

8 B. IT IS AN ACT OF UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT FOR A HEALTH CARE
9 PROVIDER TO DENY A CLAIM WITHOUT AN INDIVIDUAL REVIEW OF THE CLAIM.

10 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "HEALTH CARE PROVIDER" MEANS A
11 PERSON WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13 OR 17.
