AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1046, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
ADMINISTRATIVE RULES OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 41-1046, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:
4 41-1046. Administrative rules oversight committee;
5 membership; appointment; staffing; meetings
6 A. The administrative rules oversight committee is established.
7 The committee has oversight over any rules except those rules exempted by
8 section 41-1005.
9 B. The committee consists of the following eleven members:
10 1. Five members of the house of representatives who are appointed
11 by the speaker of the house of representatives. ~~no~~ NOT more than three of
12 the members who are appointed under this paragraph may be members of the
13 same political party. The speaker of the house of representatives shall
14 designate a member to serve as cochairperson of the committee.
15 2. Five members of the senate who are appointed by the president of
16 the senate. ~~no~~ NOT more than three of the members who are appointed under
17 this paragraph may be members of the same political party. The president
18 of the senate shall designate a member to serve as cochairperson of the
19 committee.
20 3. The governor or the governor's designee who is not an appointed
21 agency director.
22 C. The speaker of the house of representatives and the president of
23 the senate shall make the appointments to the committee on or before
24 October 1, 2009. Members serve at the pleasure of their respective
25 appointing officer.
26 D. The ~~legislative council~~ RESEARCH DIRECTORS OF THE SENATE AND THE
27 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR THEIR DESIGNEES, shall staff the committee.
28 E. The committee shall meet on the call of either of its
29 cochairpersons.
30 F. A party contesting the legality of a rule, agency practice or
31 substantive policy statement is not required to file a complaint with the
32 committee to exhaust its administrative remedies.
