A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENACTING AND ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE PEOPLE OF A MEASURE RELATING
TO HORSE AND DOG RACING.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:
3 1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the legislature,
4 the following measure, relating to horse and dog racing, is enacted to
5 become valid as a law if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
6 Governor:

7 AN ACT

8 AMENDING SECTION 5-103.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING
9 TO HORSE AND DOG RACING.

10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

11 Section 1. Section 5-103.01, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 is amended to read:

13 5-103.01. Prohibited activities

14 An employee or appointee of the commission may not:

15 1. Enter into any business dealing, venture or contract
16 with an owner or lessee of a ~~race track~~ RACETRACK or any
17 permittee.

18 2. Be employed in any capacity by any race track or
19 permittee.

20 3. Participate as an owner-trainer, trainer or jockey
21 in any racing meeting conducted in this state.

22 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
23 voters at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1,
24 section 1, Constitution of Arizona.
