## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE V,  
SECTION 12, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF ELECTIVE  
STATE OFFICERS.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,  
2 the Senate concurring:

3       1. Article V, section 12, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to  
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the  
5 Governor:

6           12. Compensation of elective state officers;  
7                   commission on salaries for elective state  
8                   officers

9           Section 12. A. The salaries of those holding elective  
10          state offices OTHER THAN THE OFFICE OF STATE LEGISLATOR shall  
11          be as established by law from time to time, subject to the  
12          limitations of article 6 VI, section 33 OF THIS CONSTITUTION  
13          and to the limitations of article 4 IV, part 2, section 17 OF  
14          THIS CONSTITUTION. Such salaries as are presently established  
15          may be altered from time to time by the procedure established  
16          in this section or as otherwise provided by law, ~~except that~~  
17          ~~legislative salaries may be altered only by the procedures~~  
18          ~~established in this section.~~

19           B. A commission to be known as the commission on  
20          salaries for elective state officers is authorized to be  
21          established by the legislature. The commission shall be  
22          composed of five members WHO ARE appointed from private life,  
23          two of whom shall be appointed by the governor and one each by  
24          the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of  
25          representatives, and the chief justice. At such times as may  
26          be directed by the legislature, the commission shall report to  
27          the governor with recommendations concerning the rates of pay  
28          of elected state officers. The governor, ~~shall upon~~ ON the  
29          receipt of such report, SHALL make recommendations to the  
30          legislature with respect to the exact rates of pay ~~which he~~  
31          ~~THAT THE GOVERNOR~~ deems advisable for those offices and  
32          positions other than for the rates of pay of members of the  
33          legislature. Such recommendations shall become effective at a  
34          time established by the legislature after the transmission of  
35          the recommendation of the governor without aid of further  
36          legislative action unless, within such period of time, there  
37          has been enacted into law a statute ~~which~~ THAT establishes  
38          rates of pay other than those proposed by the governor, or  
39          unless either house of the legislature specifically  
40          disapproves all or part of the governor's recommendation. The  
41          recommendations of the governor, unless disapproved or altered  
42          within the time provided by law, shall be effective; ~~and any~~  
43          ~~1971 recommendations shall be effective as to all offices on~~  
44          ~~the first Monday in January of 1973.~~ In case of either a  
45          legislative enactment or disapproval by either house, the

1 recommendations shall be effective only insofar as not altered  
2 or disapproved. ~~The recommendations of the commission as to~~  
3 ~~legislative salaries shall be certified by it to the secretary~~  
4 ~~of state and the secretary of state shall submit to the~~  
5 ~~qualified electors at the next regular general election the~~  
6 ~~question, "Shall the recommendations of the commission on~~  
7 ~~salaries for elective state officers concerning legislative~~  
8 ~~salaries be accepted? [ ] Yes [ ] No."~~ Such recommendations  
9 ~~if approved by the electors shall become effective at the~~  
10 ~~beginning of the next regular legislative session without any~~  
11 ~~other authorizing legislation.~~ All recommendations ~~which~~ THAT  
12 become effective under this section shall supersede all laws  
13 enacted ~~prior to~~ BEFORE their effective date relating to such  
14 salaries.

15 C. THE SALARY OF THOSE HOLDING THE OFFICE OF STATE  
16 LEGISLATOR SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY LAW.

17 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the  
18 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,  
19 Constitution of Arizona.
