A PERSON WHO IS EMPLOYED AS A GENETIC COUNSELOR BY THE FEDERAL 44 45 GOVERNMENT OR A FEDERAL AGENCY IF THE PERSON PROVIDES GENETIC COUNSELING SERVICES SOLELY UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE ENTITY BY WHICH THE
 PERSON IS EMPLOYED.

A GENETIC COUNSELING INTERN IF THE GENETIC COUNSELING SERVICES 4 PERFORMED BY THE GENETIC COUNSELING INTERN ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE 5 GENETIC COUNSELING INTERN'S COURSE OF STUDY AND ARE PERFORMED UNDER THE 6 DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A GENETIC COUNSELOR WHO IS ASSIGNED TO SUPERVISE THE 7 GENETIC COUNSELING INTERN AND WHO IS ON DUTY AND AVAILABLE IN THE ASSIGNED 8 PATIENT CARE AREA.

9 4. A VISITING GENETIC COUNSELOR WHO HOLDS A CERTIFICATION, WHO IS 10 FROM ANOTHER STATE AND WHO IS PERFORMING ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES FOR A 11 PERIOD OF LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS EACH YEAR. A VISITING GENETIC COUNSELOR 12 MUST BE LICENSED OR REGISTERED IN THE STATE OF THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE IF 13 LICENSURE OR REGISTRATION IS AVAILABLE.

A. BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2025, A PERSON WHO WISHES TO PRACTICE GENETIC COUNSELING IN THIS STATE SHALL BE LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE. E. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR LICENSURE UNDER THIS ARTICLE BUT WHO HAS BEEN PRACTICING GENETIC COUNSELING IN THIS STATE BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ARTICLE AND WHO HAS WORKED IN THIS STATE AS A GENETIC COUNSELOR FOR AT LEAST EIGHT YEARS BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ARTICLE MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR LICENSURE IF THE INDIVIDUAL SUBMITS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING TO THE DEPARTMENT:

A. THE DIRECTOR MAY INVESTIGATE INFORMATION THAT INDICATES THAT A PERSON IS OR MAY BE VIOLATING THIS ARTICLE. IN CONNECTION WITH AN INVESTIGATION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXAMINE AND COPY DOCUMENTS AND OTHER PHYSICAL EVIDENCE WHEREVER LOCATED THAT RELATE TO THE CONDUCT OR COMPETENCY OF A GENETIC COUNSELOR PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE RULES ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE.

B. PURSUANT TO AN INVESTIGATION OR AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING,
THE DIRECTOR MAY ISSUE SUBPOENAS TO COMPEL THE TESTIMONY OF WITNESSES OR
TO DEMAND THE PRODUCTION OF RELEVANT DOCUMENTS AND OTHER PHYSICAL
EVIDENCE. IF A PERSON REFUSES TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOENA, THE DIRECTOR MAY
APPLY TO THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR AN ORDER TO COMPEL COMPLIANCE.

C.
