AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 13, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-1311; RELATING TO KIDNAPPING AND RELATED OFFENSES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 13, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 13-1311, to read:

4 13-1311. Unlawful disabling of location tracking application
5 or function; classification; definition

6 A. IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO KNOWINGLY DISABLE OR COERCE A
7 MINOR TO DISABLE A LOCATION TRACKING APPLICATION OR FUNCTION THAT IS
8 INSTALLED ON THE MINOR'S ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICE WHILE THE PERSON
9 IS COMMITTING OR ATTEMPTING TO COMMIT AN OFFENSE INCLUDED IN THIS CHAPTER
10 AND CHAPTERS 14 AND 35.1 OF THIS TITLE.

11 B. A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A CLASS 2 FELONY.

12 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION
13 DEVICE" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 13-3560.
