AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1093.07, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 11, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-1093.08; RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL REGULATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1093.07, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 41-1093.07. Private employers; effect of article;
5 occupational association

6 A. This article does not:

7 1. Require a private employer to grant or deny employment to any
8 individual.

9 2. Impair the right of private employers to establish and enforce
10 eligibility criteria, ethics codes or disciplinary policies.

11 B. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, AN OCCUPATIONAL ASSOCIATION THAT
12 HAS DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY OVER ITS MEMBERS MAY INVESTIGATE A COMPLAINT
13 AND TAKE DISCIPLINARY OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION RESULTING FROM A COMPLAINT
14 ONLY IF THE COMPLAINANT HAS A SUBSTANTIAL NEXUS WITH THE PERSON WHO IS THE
15 SUBJECT OF THE COMPLAINT.

17 is amended by adding section 41-1093.08, to read:

18 41-1093.08. Agency complaints; substantial nexus

19 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, AN AGENCY MAY INVESTIGATE A COMPLAINT
20 AND TAKE DISCIPLINARY OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION RESULTING FROM A COMPLAINT
21 ONLY IF THE COMPLAINANT HAS A SUBSTANTIAL NEXUS WITH THE PERSON WHO IS THE
22 SUBJECT OF THE COMPLAINT.
