AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-567; RELATING TO CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 9, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-567, to read:

4 16-567. Voting locations; harassment; peace officers

5 IF A VOTER OR ELECTION OFFICIAL, INCLUDING AN ELECTION BOARD WORKER,  
6 AT A POLLING PLACE, VOTING CENTER OR ON-SITE EARLY VOTING LOCATION  
7 OFFICIALLY COMPLAINS OF MORE THAN ONE INCIDENT OF HARASSMENT AT THAT  
8 LOCATION, THE COUNTY RECORDER OR OTHER OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS MAY  
9 REQUEST THAT A PEACE OFFICER BE DISPATCHED TO THAT POLLING PLACE, VOTING  
10 CENTER OR ON-SITE EARLY VOTING LOCATION AND REMAIN AT THAT LOCATION DURING  
11 ITS HOURS OF OPERATION.
