AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 26-305.03, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO  
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 26-305.03, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 to read:

4 26-305.03. Electromagnetic pulse preparedness  
5 recommendations; posting; update; definition

6 A. The division shall develop preparedness recommendations for the  
7 public regarding the type and quantity of supplies, including food, water  
8 and medical supplies, that each person in this state should possess in  
9 preparation for an electromagnetic pulse that might occur over the United  
10 States. The division shall post the preparedness recommendations **IN A**  
11 **VISIBLE AND PROMINENT SECTION** on **THE HOME PAGE OF** its website and shall  
12 update the preparedness recommendations at least every five years.

13 B. For the purposes of this section, "electromagnetic pulse" means  
14 a burst of electromagnetic energy occurring in the form of a radiated  
15 electric magnetic field or conducted electrical current caused by a  
16 coronal mass ejection from the sun, detonation of a nuclear bomb high in  
17 **THE** earth's upper atmosphere or a man-made electromechanical device.
