AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION STUDY COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Governor's mansion study committee; membership;
3 duties; report; delayed repeal

4 A. The governor's mansion study committee is established consisting
5 of the following members:

6 1. Three members of the house of representatives, two of whom are
7 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives from the majority
8 party and one of whom is appointed by the governor from the minority
9 party. The speaker of the house of representatives shall designate one of
10 these members to serve as cochairperson of the committee.

11 2. Three members of the senate, two of whom are appointed by the
12 president of the senate from the majority party and one of whom is
13 appointed by the governor from the minority party. The president of the
14 senate shall designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson of
15 the committee.

16 3. Three public members, one of whom is appointed by the president
17 of the senate, one of whom is appointed by the speaker of the house of
18 representatives and one of whom is appointed by the governor.

19 B. The committee shall:

20 1. Meet as often as the cochairpersons deem necessary.

21 2. Explore the possibility of building a governor's mansion in this
22 state.

23 3. On or before December 1, 2024, submit a report regarding the
24 committee's activities and recommendations to the governor, the president
25 of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and provide
26 a copy of this report to the secretary of state.

27 C. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2025.
